CREMONA MUSICA PRIZE FOR THE PIANOLINK INTERNATIONAL AMATEURS COMPETITION
2021 WON BY BARBARA BONI



Friday 22 July, in the courtyard of Palazzo Reale, Milan, where the MiAmOr Music Festival 2022 will be held, Barbara Boni will be awarded the Cremona Musica Prize for the PianoLink International Amateurs Competition 2021 (audience award) for the largest number of votes obtained for the Youtube video.

MiAmOr (Milano Amateurs & Orchestra) Music Festival, now in its seventh edition, is an international musical event for professional and amateur musicians, produced by PianoLink Musical Association with artistic director Andrea Vizzini, in collaboration with Bösendorfer and Yamaha Music Europe, and sponsored by Milan Municipality | Culture, Events Department, and the Lombardy Regional Government, with a programme of over 200 professional and amateur musicians performing on major stages.

The programme started with the opening concert on 16 July, a performance of Carl Orff's monumental Carmina Burana, in the wonderful setting of the Franco Parenti Theatre, Milan. MiAmOr included two days of public rehearsals (18 and 19 July), followed by two Gala Concerts on Friday 22 and Saturday 23 July at Palazzo Reale. The festival showcases amateur pianists from around the world - doctors, lawyers, office workers - performing the piano concerto repertoire (Addinsell, Beethoven, Saint Saëns, Haydn, Mozart, Šostakovič Beethoven, Grieg, Rachmaninov, Gershwin, Prokofiev, Ravel and Lutoslawski) with the PianoLink Philharmonic Orchestra. The PianoLink International Amateurs Competition is yet another original project from PianoLink Musical Association, now in its third year, organised in collaboration with Yamaha Music Europe and Cremona Musica. The competition for amateur musicians is currently underway, and will reach its final stage at the A. Ponchielli Theatre in Cremona during the Cremona Musica exhibition, to be held on 23-25 September at the Cremona exhibition centre.

[Cremona Musica \(September 23-25 2022\)](#) is the most important exhibition in the world for high-quality musical instruments, and it is held every year in Cremona, the birthplace of Stradivari and international center of the musical instrument sector. In addition to the instruments created by the Cremonese, Italian, and international masters, Cremona Musica hosts a rich and varied calendar of events, with concerts, exhibitions, masterclasses, competitions, conferences, with world-class artists. The event takes place in synergy and collaboration with local institutions: the Municipality, the Chamber of Commerce, the Province and Trade associations, the Museum of Violin as well as the Lombardy Region and the ICE-Agency. Despite the pandemic, the 2021 edition took place regularly and saw the participation of 215 exhibitors from 23 countries (42% foreign), with a program of over 130 events in 3 days, 300 artists and personalities involved including concerts, masterclasses and presentations and delegations of Buyers from 12 selected countries with the support of the ICE-Agency.
